Recently, I received an email from Wally Zeien about getting a long-time member's 1954 F-100 running once again after it had been in storage for 10-12 years. Wally made it known that this F-100 needed a lot of TLC and since our club is all about getting old Ford trucks back on the road, I told him this was a great idea.

Fast forward a couple of weeks later...the member has decided to sell the 1954 F-100 in "As Is" condition instead of repair it and get it running. Seems he's lost interest since he can't work on it himself for health reasons, the next generation of family shows no interest and he has other interests this time in his life.

So...I recently had the pleasure of talking with the owner of that 1954 F-100 featured on this month's cover, David Kerznar.

Yes, I've spoken with David before in emails and at one of our shows, but this time it was different. He had made a hard decision to sell his '54 F-100 that he affectionately called "Bucket". In an email David said, "There comes a time in ones life that you have to make HARD CHOICES and this one was one of the hardest". I scheduled a time during our emails to view his '54 F-100 and talk to him about advertising the truck for sale. When I arrived to meet with David, I also met David's wife Nancy and their great little companion, "Honey" the dog. David's an interesting fellow, with a very diverse background in law enforcement, gardening (you should see his yard) and wood working. David was a gracious host and proceeded to first show me around the wood shop. If you saw all the projects he's got going on, then you would know why he has other interests. David has many wood projects and makes trophies not only for our truck show but also for the Monona Grove High School. And the man has oodles of license plates hanging in the wood shop too. I marveled at how many he had and from nearly every state and many other countries too.

After we toured the wood shop, we went to the garage where the '54 F-100, dubbed "Black Beauty" by Wally Zeien, is kept. We pulled the cover off the front and there it was, dusty yet shiny and black.







Though it hasn't been started or moved in years, it still looks good. David and I talked about the truck while I walked around and took photos of it. He said the truck has a 350 Chevy engine with a Turbo 350 transmission, a 10 bolt GM rear end and a 1973 Nova front clip. He also noted the truck was built with some new old stock parts. David said the truck has maybe 2000 miles on it before being put away in 1999 for medical reasons.

David has kept all of his documentation and such throughout the years of ownership. He showed me the appraisal and photos of the truck as it was being completed.




