Fall Cruise Photos

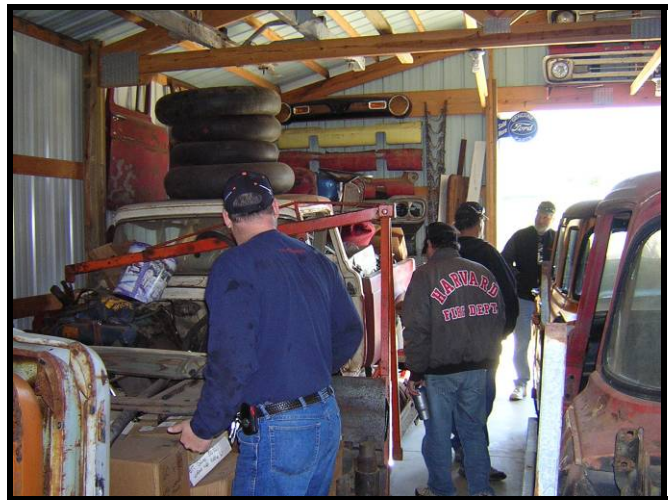


We gathered at Dave & Julie Farmer's house in Verona and started our Fall Cruise from there. We left at 11am just after being served with some breakfast bites and liquids.

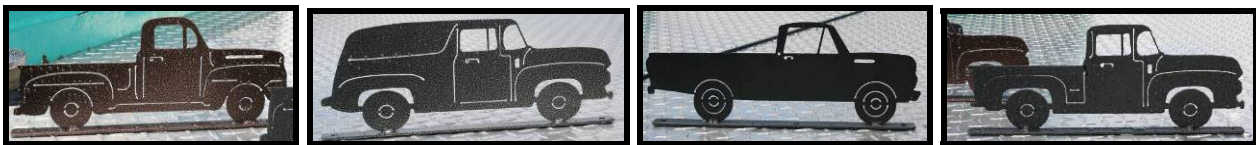

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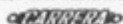
