**January Meeting:** Meeting and swap meet at Jeff Mundt's shop. The date will be announced in the December newsletter.

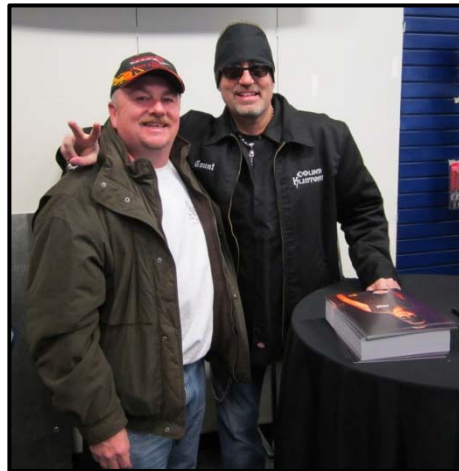

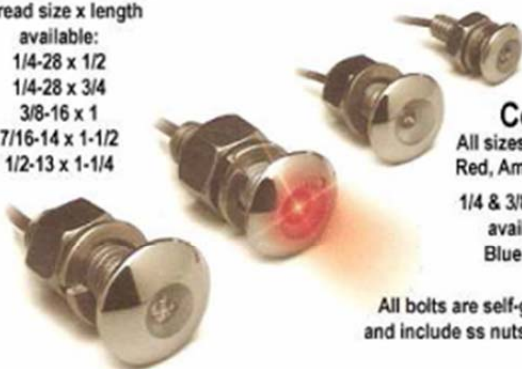

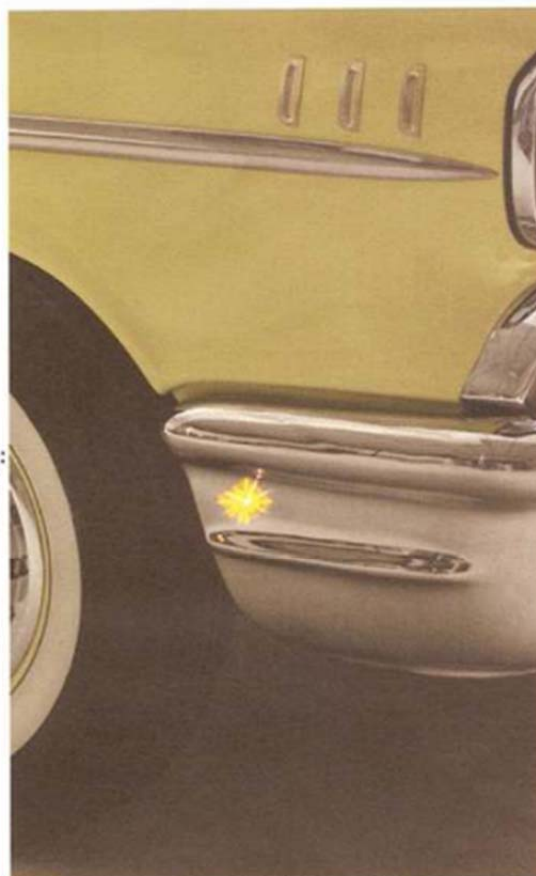
