The Valve Cover Derby Rules (as of 2014).

- Maximum Width 15"
- Maximum Length 30"
- Maximum height 10"
- Maximum weight 10 lbs (by official scale only)
- No electronic steering devices
- No engines or propulsion of any kind
- One valve cover per chassis
- No switching wheels of any kind may be used. However, the wheels cannot extend beyond the stock gasket surface.
- No movable weight
- Must maintain **"Stock Gasket Surface"**
- 4 classes will be held: Girls, Boys, Ladies, and Men
- Each participant must have his or her own Valve Cover Derby Vehicle
- Vehicles **WILL BE WEIGHED** before racing

Modified Rules

- Stock rules apply except you may modify the valve cover as long as you maintain the gasket surface.

The August Meeting Minutes

Badgerland F-100's Truck Club

Minutes of Meeting 08/23/14

Badgerland F-100 members met at Lake Joy Campground near Belmont Wisconsin at the camper of Roger and Barb McDermott. The meeting was called to order at 12:27pm by President Mike Connor with 10 adults and six Ford Trucks present.

Vice President's Report: Member Scott Jackson's mother recently passed away and a memorial service will be held Sept 27th at 11am at the Crossroads Methodist Church in Washington, Illinois. The club has already sent a card and memorial.

Rick passed around the newsletters from the Twin City F-100's and the Show Me F-100's. The Twin City newsletter mentioned the upcoming Badgerland Dash to Dells 25. The Show Me club will be ending their annual show but will continue on with other truck related events.

President's Report: Mike and Chris recently attended the Back to 50's Show in Minneapolis, Minnesota. In addition to enjoying the show they worked to publicize the Dash to the Dells 25 by handing out flyers to many Ford truck owners.

Secretary's Report: Linda Williams made a motion to accept the minutes as written in the Newsletter. Seconded by Randy Roelke. All were in favor.

Treasurer's Report: Chris Connor reported the club balance and that she had recent expenditures of approximately \$800.00 related to the upcoming Dash 25.

Membership: No new members.

New Business: Chris reminded members that we have now passed the cut-off date for the room reservations but that reservations can still be made by directly contacting the Lake Delton Great Wolf location between the hours of 9:00am and 4:30pm and asking for Gabby. There is however no guarantee that you will get the Badgerland room rate. The phone number is 608-678-5012.

As of 08/12/14 the Badgerland F-100's had surpassed the required 128 room nights with a count of 140 room night reservations. As of this meeting date of 08/23/14 we were up to 176 room nights reserved far exceeding our requirement. In return for our business, Great Wolf will supply the tent, tables, chairs, and use of parking lot for the show. Badgerland does however pay to rent the registration room.

Registration chair Barb McDermott reported 70 preregistrations as of this meeting, about ten ahead of last year for this time with several coming from out of state.

Another discussion was held regarding hiring a DJ for the show. Randy Roelke suggested use of a DJ from the area by the name of Shane Weber who plays music for local cruise nights. After much discussion a motion was made by Wally Zeien to have Randy Roelke approach DJ Shane Weber to see if Shane is available for the Dash show with a cost limit of no more than \$400, available from 10:00am to 4:30pm and would allow the club to use his PA system to announce trophies and door prizes. Seconded by Barb McDermott and all were in favor. Wally has generously offered to cover \$100 of the cost of the DJ or something else if a DJ is not used.

Regarding the Miller Welder door prize, of the \$453 cost to the club, \$392 has been covered in donations. No donations yet towards the complete truck bed from Bruce Horkey that the club will be giving away as a top door prize. Mike pointed out that this prize does not include shipping and the lucky winner will be responsible for the cost of getting it shipped to their location.

Door Prize Chair Linda Williams reports that 150 door prize beg letters have been sent by mail. Of those she has received 18 responses in the form of donations. She encourages members to keep making contact with vendors and businesses for donations. Linda will be approaching the Better Business Bureau for the Dells area to solicit donations or coupons for the local businesses.

Volunteers are still needed to fill slots for Saturday and Friday morning for the registration table, tee shirts and door prizes as well as teardown and clean up.

Trevor Rush continues to work on publicity. The usual games will be on hand such as the Hot Wheels Racing and Valve Cover Racing. Jean Hilgers will be handling the children's games and Rachel Hilgers is making all of the Hot Wheels and Valve cover trophies. Greg Master's will be bringing a trick bicycle for the adults to try their hand at.

Dave Farmer is donating the trophy tags. Jeff Mundt will supply wood for an evening fire in the parking lot. Randy Roelke is donating a customized TV stand for a door prize.

Wally reports the trophy count is at 24 with a maximum desired of 30 so as to not prolong the distribution for too long.

Other Business: Rick is encouraging all members to provide an email address to which the newsletter can be sent to get away from the cost of regular mail for the club. This has the added benefit of being able to quickly reach all members with any late breaking news or last minute announcements. A good example is if someone wanted to organize a member cruise without a lot of notice. It would be much easier to reach more members if everyone had email.

October Meeting: None scheduled yet but it appears that it will likely be held south of the border in flat land country. No November meeting location yet either.

Motion to Adjourn: By Ros Pribbenow, seconded by Wally Zeien. Meeting adjourned 2:25pm.

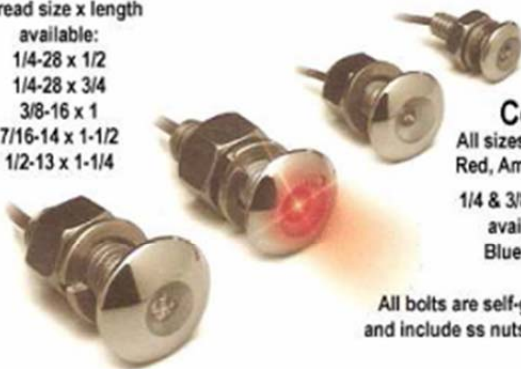

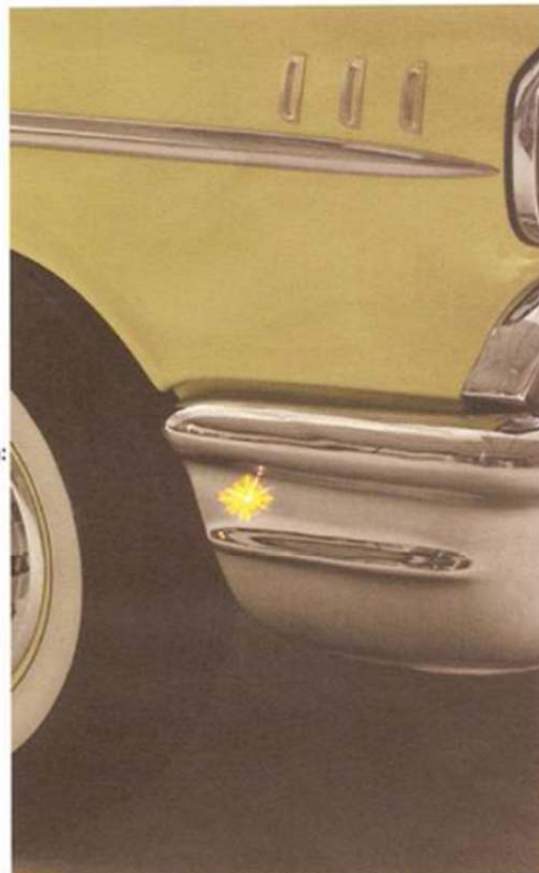
