January 2015 Meeting Minutes:

The meeting was called to order by President Mike Connor at 12:44pm. Present were 29 adults and 5 kids. No classic Ford trucks except the ones in Randy's shop.

Vice President's Report:

Rick passed around the newsletters from the Show-Me F-100's and the Twin City F-100's clubs. It was noted that the Milwaukee Car Show is being held on the weekend of 02/20/15 at State Fair Park in Milwaukee WI. Rick reminded everyone that he is looking for someone to take over the duties of the club newsletter. Any takers?

Secretary's Report:

Motion made by Dave Farmer to accept the minutes as written in the last newsletter. Seconded by Ros Pribbenow. Motion passed.

Treasurers Report:

Chris reported the balance for the club checking account. She noted that Great Wolf has never billed the club for the registration room for Dash 25 which has saved the club \$300.00.

New Members:

Old Business:

There was some final discussion on Dash 25. Mike noted that the winner of the Grand Prize, the box from Bruce Horkey, has not yet claimed his prize. Bruce Horkey will give a six month time frame for the prize to be claimed and if it is not claimed by then it will be withdrawn. The club has made no payments to Bruce Horkey for the prize and will not do so unless it is claimed in the allotted time frame.

New Business:

Mike and Chris Connor have secured a contract with Great Wolf for Dash 26. In the new contract, the room rates remain the same as last year at \$109.99 per night which is the club rate. If someone desires a different room style than that offered under the club rate, they are advised to contact Great Wolf directly for those arrangements. Cut-off date for reservations at the club rate is going to be 08/10/15. **Just a reminder that Dash 26 will be held September 18th and 19th, of 2015.

Chair persons have already come forth to volunteer for several posts for Dash 26. Barb Erbs McDermott has volunteered to be Registration Chair again. Wally Zeien will be Trophy Chair again and Jean Hilgers will act as Chair for the Kids games again. Still needed are a Door Prize and Publicity Chair plus volunteers for the many duties of putting on the show.

Discussion was held on ideas for the Grand Prize for Dash 26. After much discussion a motion was made by Dave Farmer to look for a high quality tool box to give away as a Grand Prize. Motion seconded by Barb Erbs McDermott. Motion passed.

More discussion followed on how much the club should spend towards this tool box. A motion made by Todd Showers to place a cap of \$800.00 to be spent by the club for the Grand Prize. Seconded by Randy Roelke. Motion passed. Todd Showers volunteered to do some research on different brands and styles of tool boxes. It was also pointed out that the club will accept donations towards this prize from members or vendors.

Mike passed out Thank You certificates to those who donated door prizes for Dash 25.

Discussion was held on having a DJ again at Dash 26. There were several positive comments on this idea. To help offset the cost, the club could also accept donations towards the DJ. A motion was made by Paul Hilgers to research further the cost of a DJ for Dash 26. Seconded by Dave Farmer. Motion passed.

Discussion was held on the problem of running low on food towards the end of the meal at Dash 25. Ideas were presented to prevent this from happening again. One of the issues from Dash 25 was that we had a rather larger than expected number of show day registrations. Our food vendor Rich Linskens always plans for an additional number but the turnout was even larger than expected. The club will closely monitor this year's registration and plan for extra. The rising cost of food has contributed to increased cost to the club for the show meal. Ideas were presented to offset these rising costs. One possibility was to raise the cost of show registration or raise the cost of additional meals that participants request. A motion was made by Dave Farmer to discuss this issue further with the idea that we would keep the present rate of \$25.00 for those who pre-register but increase the registration rate to \$35.00 for those who register on site. Seconded by Todd Showers. Motion Passed.

Nominations for club officers for the next year were held.

President: Dave Farmer nominated present club President Mike Connor to continue as President. Seconded by Todd Showers. Mike accepted the nomination.

Vice President: Rick Pribbenow has declined any nominations. Wally Zeien nominated Dave Farmer for Vice President. Seconded by Todd Showers. Dave accepted the nomination.

Treasurer: Floyd Johnson nominated Chris Connor to continue as Treasurer. Seconded by Ros Pribbenow. Chris accepted the nomination.

Hearing no other nominations, Wally Zeien made a motion to close nominations. Seconded by Julie Farmer. Motion Passed.

Discussion was continued from previous meetings on the issue of obtaining different styles of shirts, sweatshirts and or even jackets with the club logo. 
