No sight specified for the June meeting.

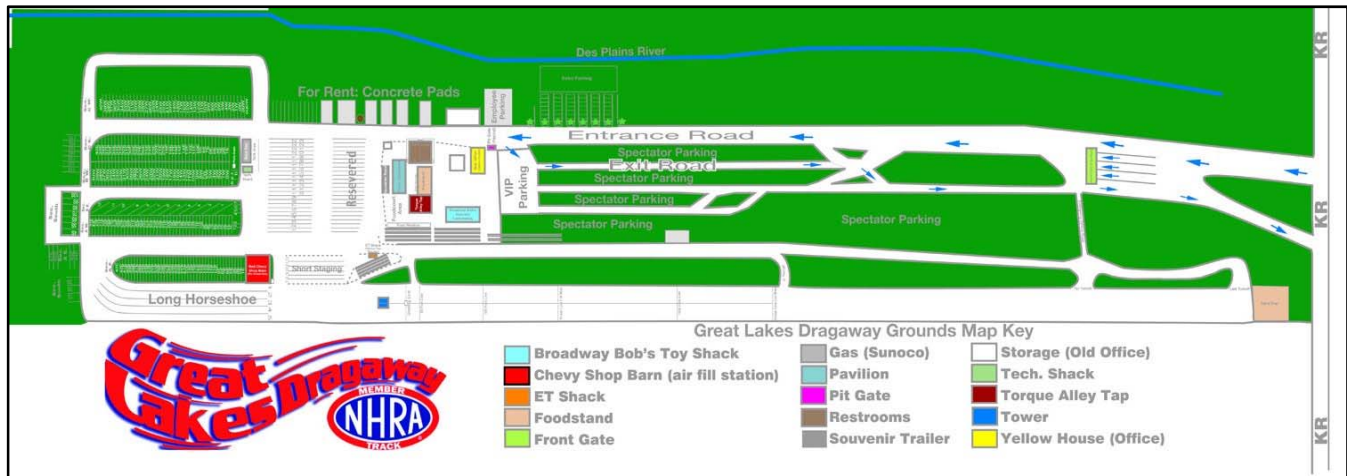
Motion to Adjourn:

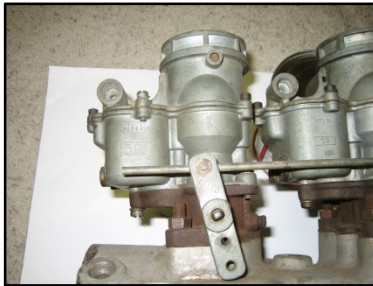

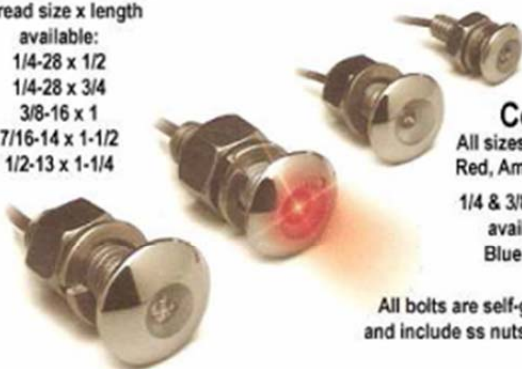

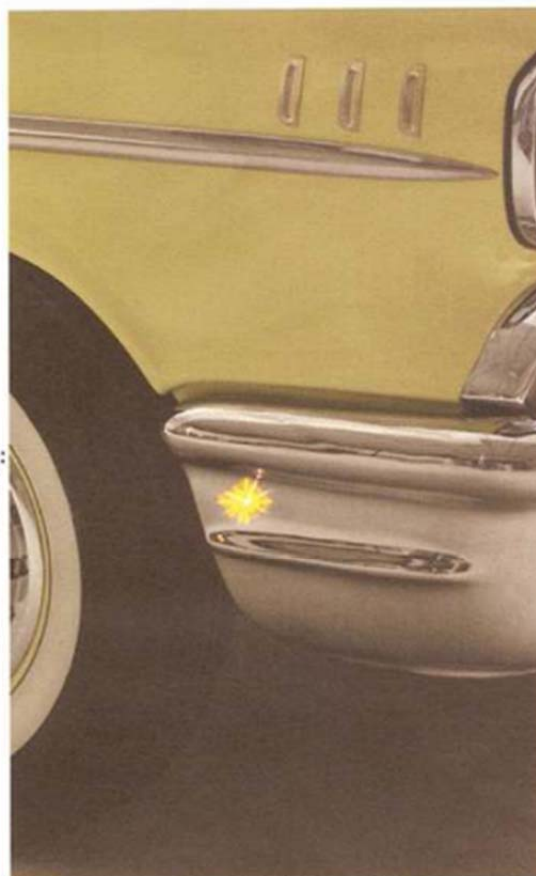
