
### **Motion to Adjourn:**

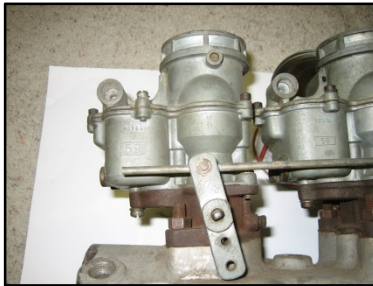

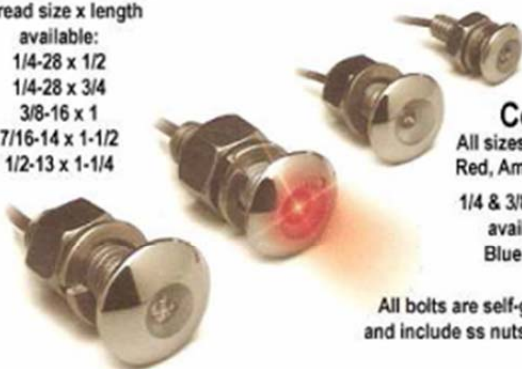
