October 2015 Meeting Minutes:

The October meeting was held on Saturday October 24th at the home of Paul and Jean Hilgers in Cross Plains and was co-hosted by Dave and Julie Farmer. The meeting followed a cruise from the Farmer residence in Verona to the Lake Louie Brewery in Arena where those present toured the brewery and talked with the owner.

The meeting was called to order at 4:10pm by President Mike Connor. Present were 18 adults, no kids and 5 Ford trucks.

Vice Presidents Report:

Dave is starting a new list for members interested in purchasing club shirts such as the one modeled by Mark Favor. Contact Dave if interested in purchasing a shirt.

Dave put up for discussion the idea of holding some kind of charity event in conjunction with a meeting or just a weekend event and or with Dash 27. Several different ideas were presented and discussed but the subject is still open to other ideas and discussion. Some of the ideas presented included a can drive for a local food pantry, or a truck run. More discussion to follow on this.

Secretary's Report:

Dave Farmer made a motion to accept the minutes as written in the September Newsletter. Seconded by Chuck Rogers. Motion Passed.

Treasurer's Report:

Chris reported the balance of the club checkbook. She reports that the majority of the expenses associated with Dash 26 have been paid. Unlike last year we were billed for the room rental this year. A preliminary estimate is that the club will come out about \$700 in the black from Dash 26.

Old Business:

Dash 26:

Food – Chris received a lot of compliments on the lunch and everyone had enough to eat. Mike felt it went over well with the officers helping serve and it provided a chance to mingle with those coming through the line.

Great Wolf – Chris reported that overall things went much smoother this year and motel staff was very accommodating. One issue was that staff had directed those with trailers to park the trailers in the show lot. This took up room for show vehicles and with well over a hundred registrations we now need all of the show lot for show vehicles. This issue has already been addressed for Dash 27 and we have been given permission to park the trailers in the far lot by the Magic Quest building.

DJ: Somewhat mixed reviews on the DJ with the primary concern being his lack of an agenda which is perhaps the clubs fault for not providing much guidance, his constant chatter and therefore lack of music. No issues with the music selection that was played but would like to hear more music. Rick Pribbenow complimented the playing of the National Anthem (Mike Connor's request) at the beginning of the show and based on the positive response that will likely become an annual tradition.

Registration: Final registration count was 122 with 85 preregistrations.

Grand Prize: Congrats to grand prize winner Don Zollars who won the big tool box. For Dash 26 the club gave away the large tool box which cost the club \$575.00. Of that amount only \$120.00 was received in donations as opposed to last year when we had received a majority of the cost of the welder in donations. This was one of the factors that contributed to a loss on the show.

Financial: As noted earlier the club is looking at a loss for Dash 26. Randy Roelke initiated a discussion on whether having a loss due to putting on the show is a major concern. It was pointed out that the club is a 'Not For Profit' Organization and providing it does not become substantial, having a loss as a result of putting on the annual Dash is nothing to get overly worried about. Dave also gave a reminder that the club subsidized the Distillery tour for those on the cruise.

Trophies: A list of trophy winners was not available at meeting time but is going to be included elsewhere in the new letter.

New Business:

Dash 27:

Great Wolf has already offered a contact for Badgerland to hold Dash 27 at their facility next year. The new contract will have no increase in room rates and will in fact offer a discount for those staying three nights from \$109 per night to \$103.99 per night. Cindy Favor inquired about being able to get a suite under the Badgerland block of rooms. Chris reported that after Dash 26 she spoke with a Great Wolf sales person and asked this very question. At this point it does not appear that suites will be available under the Badgerland block of rooms but a discount may be available for those wishing to book suites individually. Following discussion Randy Roelke made a motion to accept the Great Wolf contract. Seconded by Barb Erbs McDermott. Motion passed.

Registration: There were a couple different discussions held regarding registration for the Dash. Registration Chair Barb Erbs McDermott inquired if she could email registration confirmations as opposed to using snail mail. This would save the club some mailing costs (paper, envelopes, postage) and would save Barb some labor in stuffing envelopes. This would apply of course only for those pre-registrants who provide an email address with their registration. This could be encouraged with a note on the yet to be developed show flyer and registration form.

In an effort to further encourage preregistration which helps with planning for food and other items, Randy Roelke presented the idea of offering a drawing for all who preregistered to win a free room night or some other incentive. An alternative idea was a \$100 gift card to Great Wolf which could be applied to a room or whatever the winner wished. The incentive would be announced in the show flyer. This idea was tabled at the meeting to give Chris opportunity to contact Great Wolf and look into it further.

DJ: Following a lengthy discussion on the pros and cons of this year's DJ, a motion was made by Jean Hilgers to hire the same DJ for Dash 27 but with implementing a more specific agenda. Motion seconded by Floyd Johnson. Motion passed. Jean has been tasked with developing the guidelines and she asked for input and or ideas on what you would like to hear from the DJ. Randy Roelke volunteered to make contact with the DJ and see if he can be reserved for Dash 27.

Volunteers: Mike thanked all who helped in any way with Dash 26. For Dash 27 however we need specific volunteers ahead of time to oversee and administer the games as there was some confusion and delay this year in getting the games started.
