March 2016 Winter Banquet Meeting Minutes:

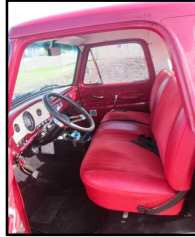

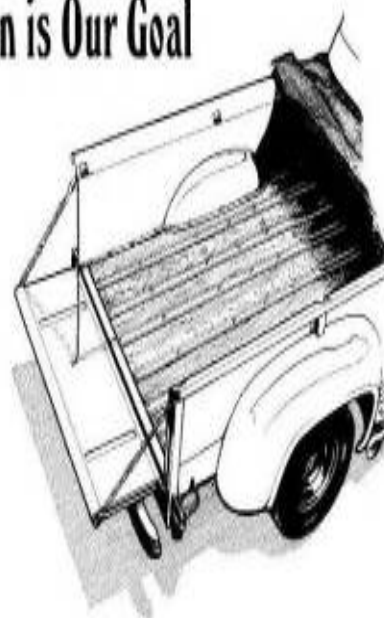

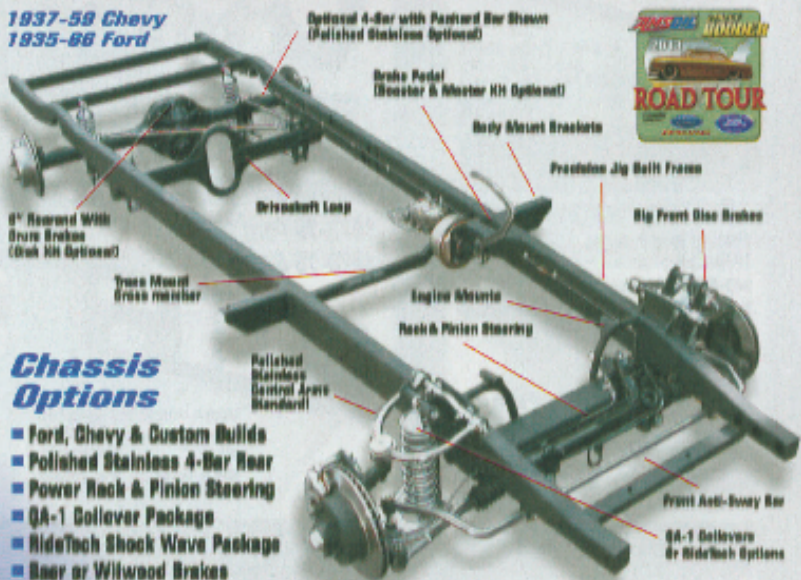
