More discussion was held on the Baggo Tournament and how to make it more efficient. The idea was suggested that if a participant does not report within five minutes of their name being called then that player would be out. It was also discussed that we could use up to six sets of boards. Some present at the meeting volunteered to bring extra sets of boards. Dave Farmer volunteered to assist Wally with management of the tournament if necessary.

Discussion followed about a larger prize at the show. It was decided that our \$500.00 gift certificate from Fatman Fabrications would be the large prize this year. Discussion followed on how to present a thank you to Fatman who has supported the Dash for many years. One idea was to take a group picture of previous winners or of club members present, make it into a poster and have everyone sign it and present it to the owner of Fatman.

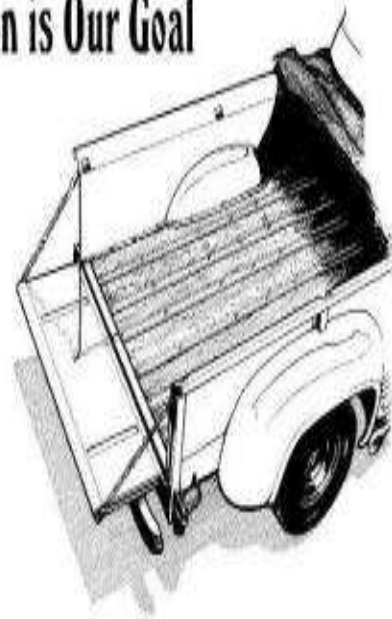
