What Are You Working On.

Winter Projects for My Truck- by Bob Kulinski

This winter is no different than others that have past. I have mental pictures of what I'd like to work on during the hibernation months so that I'm ready for the upcoming driving season. I've emotionally struggled with the stance and ride quality of the rear suspension of my F250 for years. After a lot of experimentation since the fall of 2014, followed by adding a c-notch in the frame and rebuilding the spring hangers, the fall of 2015 I had finally had the ride height I wanted for the rear of the truck. Unfortunately, the ride wasn't to my liking. So I'm back to having the springs above the rear axle. The look isn't as low as I wanted, but lower than it was, and the ride is pretty good. I'm going to leave the rear suspension alone this year - at least that's what I've told my neighbors.

So, having stated that, here's what I like to accomplish this non-driving season. I need to install the wire harness I finally purchased. I've been driving the truck with the harness from the 1978 Mark V I took all of my drive line components from. It's been working fine until August of 2016 when I noticed the lights turning off and on when I used them during my return from a car show. (Luckily I didn't need them to drive home as the sun was just setting.) Upon arriving at home I tested the lights to see if driving was the cause of the light flicker. I found that even without the engine running both parking lights and head lights would flicker and make the needle on the voltage gauge dance. So, in early January I took a road trip to Kwik Wire (Fond du lac, WI)to see what their company looked like and purchased a Ford 14 circuit harness for my truck.) So during the week of Jan. 29th I started to decipher the wire harness to see what I had to work with. I rerouted some of the wires in the factory bundles to other bundles and have a better idea of how I'll wire the truck. The completion of this project will have to wait for warmer outdoor temperatures. In the meantime, I'd appreciate any tips on how to route the wires from the cab into the engine bay as concealed as possible, from club members who have done so. Thanks!

Another project I've started is the covering of the '59 Chevy tail light housings which extend into the bed of my truck. I've drawn a plan to create a compartment which will cover the housings and wiring as well as store a jack and a few other necessary items. I purchased the materials I need yesterday and will start assembling the final product the week of Feb. 12th. Earlier this winter, I installed a pair of Quik-Latch Mini Latches into my bed cover to help secure it. This project is 75% done as I'm waiting for warmer weather to spray the vinyl glue onto the cover before reinstalling the vinyl and trim pieces. The last project on my winter's list is to (finally) create some trim around the quad headlights. Not sure what/how I'll create something at this point.
