

## What Are You Working On?

So I didn't get any photos or articles from anyone for this newsletter, so I will take the liberty of filling in some space to show you my hot rod circa early days, doing a lot of body work. Some of the photos are before and after pictures. Several of the pictures show you what I had to work with before installing the front cab corners. As you can see, there wasn't much to start with, especially the 3 triangulated pieces that fit into the fromt of each corner. They had to be removed, fabricated, and mirror duplicated for the other side, and then welded into place for support in the corners of the cab.









These next photos show the progress of welding the corners & blending them into the existing body panels. It may look crappy but I'm not a body man so it is what it is. Hopefully with enough bondo & sandpaper it won't show up too much when I finally paint it.

## What Are You Working On continued?









If one of the photos looks familiar you might have a Taurus, I used the structure under the hood of a Taurus for the main support. I had access to plenty of free sheet metal since I worked at Kayser Ford and could raid the metal dumpster whenever I needed. One of my best purchases was that of a bead roller as you can see in the last photo, The floor & fire wall got massive amounts of rolled beads for strength. I even made some different dies for the roller on my lathe.


