SEMA ACTION Network alert

This is about legislation (A.B.554/ S.B.458) This is a bill introduced in Wisconsin that would allow vehicles manufactured without a front license plate bracket and special collector's special interest vehicles the option to display only a single license plate on the rear of the vehicle. This bill has been referred to the Senate Transportation, Military and Veterans Affairs Committee and the Assembly Transportation Committee.

You can shape the course of this proposal. Request support for this legislation by sending a letter, e-mailing, or calling your legislator today to tell them you want this passed. You can also contact the members of the mentioned committees directly.






