Motion to adjourn was made by Bob Meyer and seconded by Erin Zeien.

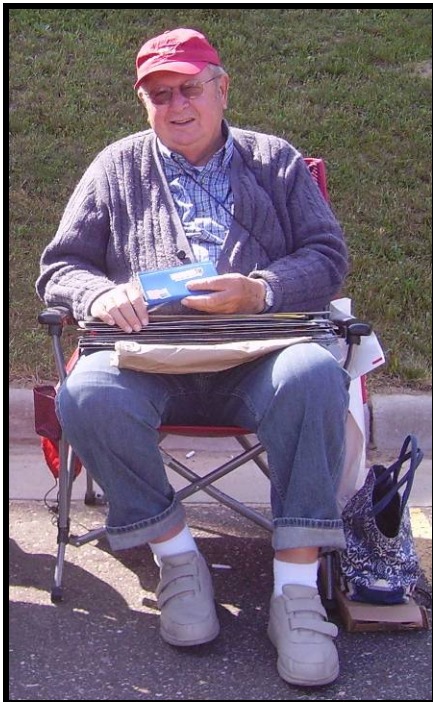



But within the last year or so I have been able to do some things and started feeling a lot better.

Then PAUL "WALLY" ZEIEN sent me an e-mail wanting to get BUCKETS or as WALLY called her, BLACK BEAUTY on the road again. My first thought was "WOW - want a great idea", but on second thoughts and after a long talk with my family - I realized that at the age of 71, I was no spring chicken, plus I wasn't able to do all the things that I was able to do, I did in years past. So I made the decision to SELL BUCKETS to a club member who would be able to bring her back to her past glory. With RICK PRIBBENOW's help and an article and ad in the FLYER, I was able to sell her to a club member in less than a week, who I know will bring her back and he promised to bring her over for a ride when it's done.

With members like that, the club is more than a CLUB, its a organization of FRIENDS who help friends , and the CLUB really came through "BIG TIME". I want to thank everyone who wanted to help bring her back and WALLY and RICK for their help in finding several members who were interested in a GREAT TRUCK. So with members like that, even without a F-100, I want to stay involved with the club and make awards and do what I can to make it a GREAT CLUB for a GREAT BUNCH of MEMBERS.

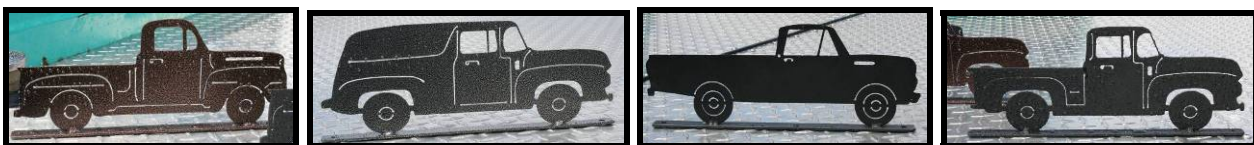

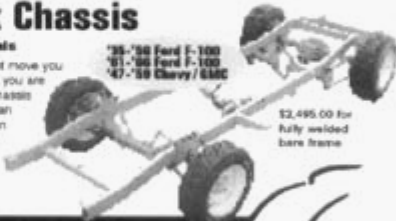
