From Reedsburg take Highway 23 South to Leland Road, left on Leland Road to Dale Road, left on Dale Road to fire number 58222 (on right). From Spring Green take Highway 23 North to Leland Road, right on Leland Road, left on Dale Road to fire number 58222 (on right). Lost? Call the number above.

The Valve Cover Derby Rules

- Maximum Width 15"
- Maximum Length 30"
- Maximum height 10"
- Maximum weight 10 lbs. (by official scale only)
- No electronic steering devices
- No engines or propulsion of any kind
- One valve cover per chassis
- No switching wheels of any kind may be used. However, the wheels cannot extend beyond the stock gasket surface.
- No movable weight
- Must maintain "**Stock Gasket Surface**"
- 4 classes will be held: Girls, Boys, Ladies, and Men
- Each participant must have his or her own Valve Cover Derby Vehicle
- Vehicles **WILL BE WEIGHED** before racing

Modified Rules

- Stock rules apply except you may modify the valve cover as long as you maintain the gasket surface.

Remember if you pay your dues after January 31st, you'll have to pay an additional \$2 for each month that you are late.

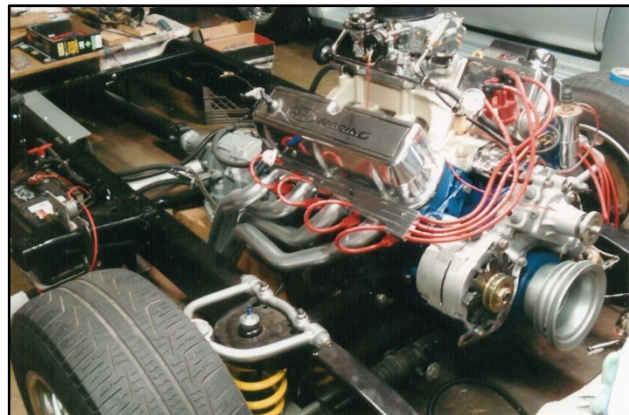
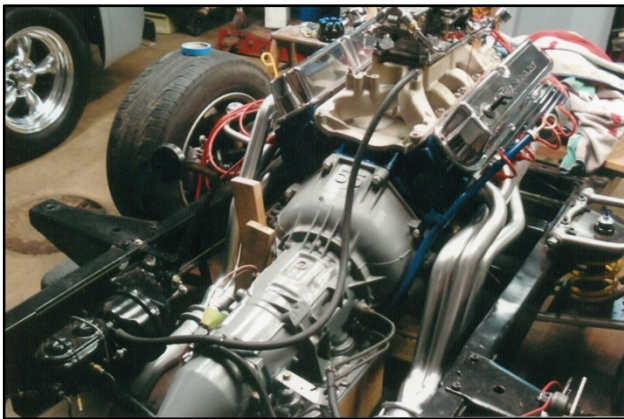
