From The Editor:

As most of you know I haven't been able to work on my truck since I had heart surgery in Nov 2014 & after I was released to start doing normal things around the house & in the garage I had a "honey do" list that took from the fall of 2015 to the summer of 2016 to complete, at least enough that I could once again work on the truck. My son & grandson came over & pulled the trans & driveshaft out as well as removed the oil pan so we could replace the rear main seal & install the new oil pan (after modifying my Holman Moody windage tray, from a GT40 Mirage, to fit with the new pan). We ended up pulling the motor since it was easier to fit the pan with the engine on the engine stand. Got all that done but before reinstalling it all I replaced my manual rack & pinion with a power rack. Then I put the engine back in & started on the power steering hoses, a nightmare since the pump is for a 1972-74 Maverick, etc. & the rack is for a 1082-88 Tbird & the hose fittings don't match. Called around to no avail until a company in Madison that makes industrial hoses (way too big for little PS pumps) suggested Hartland Service in Hartland, WI (about 1/2 hour north of Milwaukee. I took my pump & hoses there to start with the pressure line coming from the pump which took them all of maybe 20 minutes to rectify & what I thought was a very good price. I now have some mockups of the rest of the pressure & return hoses & will be going back there to have the rest of the hoses fixed to fit. They also do wiring, brake lines, PS lines as well as A/C lines. Being close to Milwaukee they have a good amount of Hot Rod clientele. If you are in need of anything like that contact them at 262-367-4234 or go online & contact them thru www.hartlandservice.com, at least they were good to me & I would recommend them.
