From Rick's Kitchen:

Cheesy Creamy Chicken Spinach Vegetable Soup

Ingredients

1 can chicken stock 14 oz.
3 tablespoons of butter
10 teaspoons of flour
2 cups of cheddar cheese
One 12 oz can of evaporated milk
12 oz baby spinach fresh
2 cups cut up pre-cooked chicken breast
Small can of peas and carrots
One small can of corn

Directions

You will need 2 pots. In the first pot place the chicken broth, bring it to a boil, add cut-up chicken, spinach, corn, peas and carrots. Bring it to a boil again and then set aside.

In the second pot, melt the butter, add the flour and make a roux. Add the evaporated milk and cheese, and then stir until smooth. In the pot with the cheese sauce, add the contents of the first pot. Stir constantly until you get to the consistency you prefer. Enjoy!


