AUGUST MEETING MINUTES:

Dash to the Dells 29 & 15th Unofficial Panel Nationals Sept. 14-15, 2018

- Flyers were available at the meeting
- Registration: Theresa Sonn reported 69 Pre-Registrations with 71 trucks.
- Door Prizes: Bob Kulinski reported that we were about where we were in previous years for solicited door prizes from vendors.
- Trophies: Rick Pribbenow reported that there are now 25 trophies being made by various people (some members doing more than one). Greg Schneider will be making the Kid's Hot Wheels trophies and all the valve cover trophies. Trophies requiring voting are Ladies Choice, Kid's Choice, Participants Choice – Panel, and Participant's Choice (ballots will be made by the Registration Chair)
- Food: We will be having pretty much the same menu as last year.
- Volunteer list: The list was circulated at the meeting. There were still open slots that needed to be filled. Let Mike Connor know if you want to volunteer for any open duties.
- Baggo: Wally had advised us that he would need 3 more sets of Baggo boards at the show and would prefer the vinyl faced type like he made for the club, so all boards play the same. The Hilgers and Roelkes will make theirs available. Still need one more set.
- Jean Hilgers will be in charge of Kid's Games/Hot Wheel Racing and Megan Connor will be in charge of the valve cover races.
- DJ: Randy Roelke reported that he has secured the same DJ as last year for the same price.
- Great Wolf hotel rooms: Chris Connor reported that we have filled our required quota for room reservations, but there were still rooms available in our room block.
- Show area at the Great Wolf: Mike reported that he was at the hotel and checked on the clean-up of the stuff stored at the outlet mall end of the parking lot. Much is gone, but they still have a semi-trailer and a few piles of things stored down there. We have asked for pallets to be removed off the lot, as well as weeds along the perimeter and islands of the parking lot to be cut. 
