# Club Meetings/Functions:

## **OCTOBER MEETING MINUTES:**

The October 20, 2018 meeting took place at the home of Randy & Diane Roelke in Loganville, WI. Thanks to Randy & Diane, as well as Dave & Julie Farmer for hosting the meeting. The meeting followed a great cruise and a chili lunch. The meeting was called to order at 1:40 pm with 7 trucks, 1 jeep, and 20 adults present.

**Vice President:** Scott Jackson was unable to attend as he had to work.

**Treasurer's report:** Chris Connor gave the Treasurer's report. She reported that we had several new members that joined or re-joined the club at the truck show.

**Secretary's report:** There was no meeting in September because of the show, so there were no minutes.

Mike Connor thanked the Roelkes for the cruise and the Farmers for the chili.

## **OLD BUSINESS:**

**Dash 29 – 2018 Recap** – Good things and issues that arose:

Mike thanked the chairs for all their time and effort both before and after the show. He realizes it's a big-time commitment for some of the positions and he appreciates it as do the participants. He also thanked everyone that stepped in to volunteer. The show runs more smoothly and was a bigger success due to all the help.

**Registration** – 111 registrations; 65 trucks were out on the cruise.

**Trophies** – Barb McDermott suggested the trophies not be exposed to the sun in the future, as it affected a few trophies. Rick Pribbenow indicated that there was a good number of trophies and thanked the trophy makers.

**DJ** – Randy Roelke did not like the music. The DJ has everything computerized and pre-set so there wasn't much in the way of 1950s and 1960s music. Other people heard similar comments. It was agreed to ask him (if he is to be hired again) to play more of the 1950s and 1960s. Todd Showers suggested we change the location of the DJ to the west end of the tent. This would relieve some congestion by the registration table area.

**Games** – It was suggested that the Kids Games and Baggo games be moved to the southwest end of the parking lot, so the aisles are less congested.

**Valve Cover Races** - Randy thanked Megan Connor for doing a great job on the valve cover races.

**Vendor, Games, etc. Layout** – Randy Roelke suggested we relocate the vendors to the west of the tent, so we have more trucks by the tent and they don't disturb the awards when packing up. He also suggested that we have a set layout for the vendors, games, canopies.

**Door prizes:** Thank you's are available – Please contact Mike or Chris if you need one.

**Food:** Chris reported on the number of meals provided. We had an amount slightly above the contracted amount. Mark Favor made a **motion** to pay Smoken Pig Express an additional \$75 towards the additional meals. 2<sup>nd</sup> to the motion made by Jean Hilgers. Motion passed. We also discussed the coffee in the Registration Room in the hotel. While people liked it, our contract with the Great Wolf does not allow us to bring our own food and beverage into the hotel.

**Hotel** – Chris reported the main issue has been when people call to make reservations. The parking lot was much better and cleaned up.

**Cruise** – The cruise was a good route. \$50 was donated by the club to the Badger Ammunition museum for letting us visit. The Sauk County Sheriff Dept. contacted the club President to advise him that during the cruise several people didn't stop at a stop sign and almost caused an accident. A driver had a dash cam and recorded the incident. Nobody was ticketed but they asked that we make everyone aware they must obey all stop signs/lights during the cruise. Since we sponsor the cruise, we are responsible for advising our participants of this. They also offered traffic control help if contacted far enough in advance and they had officers available. We may have to have a driver's meeting in the future and it was also suggested to put something about this on the Cruise Directions.

**Trailer Parking:** The place the trailers were parked at seemed to work out fine. There were a couple of incidents of loading or unloading trailers in the show area on Friday that were discussed. It was mentioned that it was more important that this wasn't happening during the show on Saturday.

### **NEW BUSINESS:**

The Club has been approached to sell vehicles on our Facebook page by non-members. Dave Farmer made a motion to not allow this, as the FB page is there to propagate the enjoyment of our club and the vehicles and there are other pages to sell parts and vehicles. Chuck Rogers 2<sup>nd</sup> the motion. Motion passed.

**Door Prize for 30<sup>th</sup>:** Randy Roelke will pick up the table set when Floyd finishes it so it can get to Wally for the powder coating. Then it will need to go back to Floyd and Rita for finish assembly.

**2019 Contract with the Great Wolf** – Discussion on whether to sign contract for the Great Wolf. Motion made by Todd Showers to negotiate and authorize Chris to sign a contract, 2<sup>nd</sup> by Jean Hilgers. Barb McDermott requested that we ask for discounts on upgraded rooms at the Great Wolf. A discussion followed about the Great Wolf's policy on providing food on their property, vendor requirements, etc. Chris explained that normally they do not allow anyone other than their own catering to provide food. This is being allowed for us as a grandfathered exception. They require a licensed vendor, and Rick Linsens has had to sign a waiver. Smoken Pig is unavailable for the Dash 30 date for the type of food they have been providing, but may be willing to have Lisa attend the show and provide sub sandwiches, chips and a drink. He will be sending us a proposal on that. We had further discussion about the hotel providing food, whether we could bring food in ourselves, or if we should even provide a lunch. Barb McDermott suggested not having lunch as part of the registration for the 30<sup>th</sup>

anniversary might not be the best idea. The motion to allow Chris to sign a new contract was dependent on it not significantly changing from previous years. If anything significant came up in the negotiations, she would bring it back to the club at the November meeting. Motion to sign the contract passed with future discussions and decisions on the food/lunch.

**Verbiage on Show Logo (Shirts/flyers)** – Randy Roelke made a motion to remove “Unofficial Panel Nationals” from the show, including the artwork (t-shirts), Todd Showers 2<sup>nd</sup>. Discussion followed on where and why this part of the show originated. Randy felt there were not enough panels attending to warrant this, and felt it was taking up too much billing in the show logos. Mike explained that an F-100 panel was featured on the artwork this year because of it being the 15<sup>th</sup> Unofficial Panel Nationals. Motion passed to remove the Unofficial Panel Nationals, with Mike Connor opposing.

**30<sup>th</sup> Artwork** – Barb McDermott made a motion to have a contest or to be able to offer concepts for the Dash 30 artwork, 2<sup>nd</sup> by Chad Hollembeak. The artwork concept should be submitted by the January meeting. Discussion followed about the type of art needed for screen printing. Sean Connor has been involved with this in the past years and may be able to assist us again depending on what we come up with.

**Door Prize Donation for Dash 30:** Mike read a letter from Rick Morris (Michigan Rick) who owns a bicycle shop, that he is making a Badgerland or F-100 themed bicycle to be given away at Dash 30.

Best pumpkin pie ever!

### CRUSTLESS PUMPKIN PIE

$\frac{3}{4}$  c sugar  
2 eggs  
 $\frac{1}{2}$  c Bisquick  
(1) 16 oz pumpkin  
2 tbsp margarine  
 $2\frac{1}{2}$  tsp pumpkin pie spice  
(1) 13oz can evaporated milk  
2 tsp vanilla

Mix together until smooth, grease one pie tin, and pour mixture into pan. Heat oven to 350 degrees. Bake 50 to 55 minutes or until knife inserted in center comes out clean. Recipe can be doubled and put into a 9 x 13 inch cake pan. Bake for the same amount of time. Top with whip topping and enjoy.

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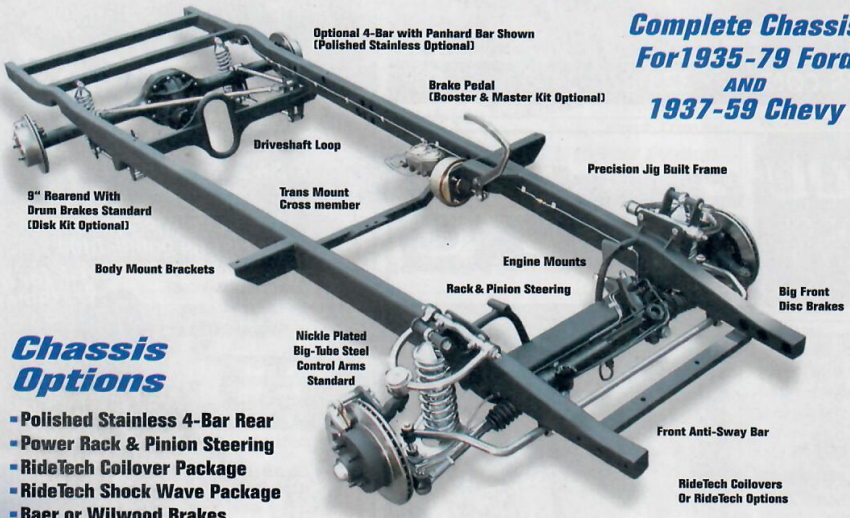


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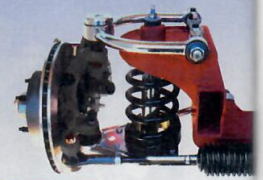
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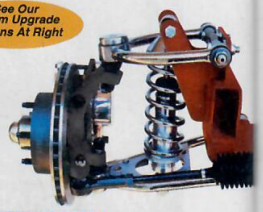
